

# 2007 ISAT Testing Schedule

All ISAT test sessions are a **minimum of 45 minutes in length**. Any student who is actively engaged in testing after 45 minutes has elapsed will be allowed up to an additional 10 minutes to complete that test session.

**The following note applies to ALL test sessions:** Students with IEPs are still allowed extended time as set forth in their IEP. Students classified as limited-English proficient (LEP) who take ISAT are allowed extended time beyond the extra 10 minutes. However, this must be predetermined locally and students must be tested separately.

<b>2007 Reading ISAT Grades 3-8</b>	
Session 1	6 short passages--30 multiple-choice items total (All 30 items are an abbreviated form of the Stanford 10.)
Session 2	1 longer passage with 16-17 multiple-choice items 1 extended-response item 1 functional passage with 3-4 multiple-choice items
Session 3	2 passages with 10 multiple-choice items each 1 extended-response item
<b>(At each grade some items will be pilot items.)</b>	

<b>2007 Mathematics ISAT Grades 3-8</b>	
Session 1	40 multiple-choice items (30 of these items are an abbreviated form of the Stanford 10.)
Session 2	30 multiple-choice items 3 short-response items
Session 3	2 extended-response items
<b>(At each grade some items will be pilot items.)</b>	

<b>2007 Science ISAT Grades 4 and 7</b>	
Session 1	40 multiple-choice items (30 of these items are an abbreviated form of the Stanford 10.)
Session 2	40 multiple-choice items
